The State Department for University Education is in receipt of a letter dated 14th September, 2021 Ref. No. KEBR/EDU/6/VOL.II(30) from Embassy of the Republic of Kenya in Belgium, Luxembourg and Mission to the European Union Brussels on the above subject.

The European University of Luxembourg Research Institute (EUNI) is a private state accredited research institute eligible for Luxembourg's National Research Funding (FNR) that exemplifies the FNR's most highly valued criteria which are excellence and quality in research.

The European University of Luxembourg Research Institute seeks to identify promising research projects and researchers for the "Industrial Fellowships" programme, for assessment of eligibility. Successful post-doctorate applicants will receive approximately 47,000 euros per year for 1 – 2 years, (4 years for PhD grants). The requirements are:

- Affiliation with a public institution in Kenya
- Ability to teach 2 – 3 online graduate courses per academic year
- Visits to the Luxembourg campuses and institutes for 3 months, over the course of each year.
