**SAFEGUARDS TRAINEESHIP PROGRAMME FOR YOUNG GRADUATES AND JUNIOR PROFESSIONALS, 1 FEBRUARY 2022 TO 30 NOVEMBER 2022**

The Secretariat of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) informs that the IAEA's Safeguards Traineeship Programme for Young Graduates and Junior Professionals will be conducted from 1 February 2022 to 30 November 2022, subject to the approval by the General Conference in September 2021.

The Traineeship Programme seeks to increase the number of qualified candidates from developing countries for positions of safeguards inspector in the IAEA or in their national nuclear organization. It will enhance their technical skills, competence and broaden their knowledge about the peaceful application of nuclear techniques and their implementation. Up to nine Safeguards Traineeships will be awarded for the year 2022. Candidates should be between 24 and 36 years old. Preference will be given to candidates from countries under-represented in the IAEA's Secretariat or countries with no or limited nuclear fuel cycle related activities. It should be pointed out that Kenya does not currently have a safeguards inspector at the IAEA (*See attached Note to Governors*).

It would be appreciated if the attached note verbale, programme description and application forms could be shared with the focal points namely the Nuclear Power and Energy Agency (NuPEA), the Kenya Nuclear Regulatory Authority (KNRA) and the University of Nairobi, Institute of Nuclear Science & Technology with a view to nominating the most suitable candidate for the traineeship programme.

The Mission would appreciate receipt of the details of the nominee as soon as possible but not later than **20 August 2021**.
