### For the 14th HOPE Meeting with Nobel Laureates

— For PhD students and young researchers in countries/areas other than Japan —

### I. General Instructions

- 1) Please submit Application Form in A4 format in 11 point or larger letters.
- 2) Altering the size or format of the form is not allowed. If the content of application contains contradictions or omissions, it may also be treated as flawed. Note that such flaws may affect the selection results.
- 3) Please fill out the form in English.

### II. Instructions for Items on the Application Form

#### 1. Applicant

1) Name	Please write the first letter in capitals and the other letters in lower case. For your <u>family name/surname</u> , type in <u>all capital letters</u> . Please leave the column blank, if you do not have a middle name or family name. e.g.) John (blank) SMITH
2) Date of Birth	Fill in your birthday. yyyy/mm/dd ( <b>yyyy</b> : Year, <b>mm</b> : Month, <b>dd</b> : Date) e.g.) 1994/08/09
3) Gender	Check the box of relevant item.
4) Nationality/Area of Birth	Fill in your nationality or area of birth.

#### 2. Affiliation, Universities Attended and Current Research Topic

5) Institution	Fill in the name of your affiliated institution (university or research institute.)
6) School/Grade	Status: Check the box of relevant item.  Program/Department/School: Fill in the name of your affiliated program, department or school.  Present Position/Year/Grade: Fill in your present position or year/grade. e.g.) Postdoctoral Researcher e.g.) 3 <sup>rd</sup> year of PhD course

7) Universities Attended	Fill in the completion dates, name of universities or institutions, programs, departments, and schools which you attended, and degrees you received. (You should not include a degree you have not yet received.)
8) Research Field	<p>- Research Field: Check the box of relevant item that you choose for your application screening. e.g.) <a href="#">Chemistry</a></p> <p>-Specific Field: Write briefly about your specific field of research. e.g.) <a href="#">Applied chemistry</a></p>
9) Current Research Topic	Fill in briefly about your current research topic.
