Research Grants for Doctoral Candidates

Who can apply?	 Excellently-qualified doctoral candidates and young academics and scientists who have completed a Master's degree
Objective	 The aim of this grant programme is to support doctoral projects in Germany.
What can be funded?	 Research phases in Germany as part of a doctoral programme in the home country: the proposal must be coordinated with the academic advisers at the home university and in Germany Doctoral programmes: Either individual projects under the supervision of an academic adviser or participation in a structured doctoral study programme
Duration of funding	 The length of the grant depends on the funding program: Short-Term Grants: 1-6 months One-Year Grants: 7-12 months Bi-nationally supervised Doctoral Degrees: A total of no more than 2 years Doctoral programs in Germany: Up to 3 years
Value	 Monthly scholarship: 1200 € Insurance cover Travel allowance
Application Deadline	 31.10. via DAAD-Portal (<u>www.funding-guide.de</u>) Application is only valid if submitted all the required documents to the DAAD portal on time.
